## C) DIFFERENCE IN MEANING:

1) THE FIRST SENTENCE IMPLIES THAT THERE ARE SEVERAL OPEN-PLAN OFFICES. THEREFORE, THE INFORMATION ABOUT THE THIRD FLOOR IS IMPORTANT. IT DEFINES THE LOCATION OF MY OPEN-PLAN OFFICE. THE SECOND SENTENCE INDICATES THAT THERE IS ONLY ONE OPEN-PLAN OFFICE. THE INFORMATION ABOUT THE THIRD FLOOR IS NOT REALLY IMPORTANT BECAUSE THERE IS NO OTHER POSSIBLE OPTION.

2) IN THE FIRST SENTENCE, ONLY THE WELL-INFORMED EMPLOYEES LOOKED FOR A NEW JOB. THEIR ILL-INFORMED COLLEAGUES DID NOTHING. THE SECOND SENTENCE SHOWS THAT ALL OF THE EMPLOYEES GOT THE NEWS AND THEN DECIDED TO SEARCH FOR ALTERNATIVE EMPLOYMENT.
